



A. Registration


B. Online Submission Requirements

- B1. Project Overview: Provide a brief description of your robot (max 500 words with pictures / max 3 minutes video).
- B2. Technical Documentation: Include schematics, code, and sensor details.
- B3. Video Submission: Upload a demonstration video (max 3 minutes) showing your robot complete the following task.
- Remote-Controlled Robot Movement in Specified Directions, Including Forward Movement, Backward Movement, and Turning.
- B4. File Formats: Acceptable formats include PDF for documents and MP4 for videos. File size under 50mb.
- B5. Submission Channel: By clicking the 'submission' button on the website or thru the Google form link https://forms.gle/iensmVHedNBHWSGR9

C. Evaluation Criteria

- C1. Performance: Completion of tasks with a showcase session is recommended (50 points)
- C2. Technical Innovation: Creativity and complexity of the design (20 points).
- C3. Documentation: Clarity and thoroughness of technical documents and video (20 points).
- C4. Team Collaboration: Evidence of teamwork and problem-solving (10 points).
